1. Call to order

4. Treasurer Report

Starting balance: \$9113.89. New income since last report: \$0. Expenses included: \$85.49 for uniform hangers, \$902.80 for FBCC shirts and \$134.00 for the post office box

fees (annual). The PayPal account balance is \$0 and the ledger balance is \$7991.60. With a \$500 reserve, \$7491.60 is available.

Projected Income: FBCC sponsors \$250.00 (Powerhouse); and Go Gold Check from tshirts \$375.00

Projected expenses: \$206.28 for quarterly taxes and \$100.00 for thank you cards.

Deposits for 2020-2021 totalled \$22,781.63.

- Concessions - may inactivate
- Competition - may rename to travel to include away games for varsity
- Christmas party
- Banquet

8. Coach Report

Coach Bulls went over expectations and suggested that parents go over the constitution.

Payments - The camp deposit was due 5/6/21. The next payment is due Monday, 5/10. She will close the order that night. Everyone needs to pay so that all items arrive in time for camp.

Coach Bulls went over the important documents folder on the shared Google drive. They should be read only.

In order to strongly encourage following the rules, any cheerleader that has no demerits until their senior year will have to try out but will automatically make varsity.

Coach Bulls explained the merit/demerit process. Everyone starts with an 80. They can earn merits in several ways, including outside cheer, toe touches or community service. Demerits are given for things such as being late, wearing the wrong uniform or jewelry violations. Demerits become permanent if not worked off. Permanent demerits carry all year, so that at the next grading period the grade would start with a 79 with one permanent demerit. Cheerleaders can begin counting merits when school gets out.

Upcoming practices: 5/20, 5/27 and 6/3. Practice will be 4:30 to 6:00 in the small gym.

Everyone will need to complete the BISD Rank One forms, but not until instructed.

Drop forms and the hair/jewelry contract need to be turned in immediately.
